Sorry for my delayed response, I have been travelling. In terms of using Amy Etra for your wedding photography, I would highly recommend it. In my opinion, what I observed as her two greatest assets are her skills as a photographer and her attitude.

Photo quality/Skill

We thought her photos looked great. We just received our proofs and are in the process of working on the album so I cannot give you much thoughts on the quality of the final album. However, in terms of our photos, we were extremely satisfied. Amy's good eye makes her a great photographer. We had interviewed several wedding photographers and had specifically picked her because her style of photography reminded us of a German photographer that we loved. She is specifically apt at capturing faces and special moments. Our black and whites had an "old world" quality which was a sharp contrast to the very modern looking color shots. We had a good mix of black/white vs. color and some great portrait shots of guests and the wedding party. The majority of our pictures were photojournalistic which is what we had requested and she was able to capture these shots beautifully.

Attitude/Professionalism

Amy is a very professional photographer. Some people we had talked to were a "little scattered" and "not on the ball." Amy always responds to emails quickly and is very easy to deal with. She pretty much will take care of herself in making the arrangements. This is an important aspect you want to look for in the people you are working with when planning your wedding. Nothing is more stressful than someone who doesn't return phone calls, or is lagsidale with details. It makes your life much harder and causes a lot of undue stress and makes the wedding planning experience not as fun. Amy is also very accommodating and comes up with creative ideas...for example, we wanted to do some "scenic shots", she came early and scouted around the island for fields and scenic shots. Furthermore, she is not an intrusive photographer, our guests and myself hardly noticed her during the wedding. I can't even count on my fingers how many times I have been at a wedding where the photographer is obnoxiously barking out orders to the guests or been in everyone's face with their bright bulbs. I remember from past weddings that guests (including myself) have spent most of the night running away from the camera. I was actually surprised she managed to take so many pictures of us because I hardly noticed her.

Hope this is helpful and enjoy your wedding planning process!
